- Pastor Jones community mobilization Consultation services were voted on and not approved. Attendees agreed grant money could be better used.
- Talked about rental property violations of tenants and landlords and methods to address. In particular, not maintaining Rumpke garbage service required by township agreement of 2016.
- Talked about traffic violations such as speeding and blowing through stop signs. There is no enforcement and violators if caught are just left with warnings because the cost is too high to send a township officer to the courthouse downtown for court hearing.
- Talked about home owner property violations and how many are Seniors on fixed incomes that can't afford to resolve issues. Attendees mentioned we should do our best to reach out to them and volunteer to help them resolve the issue before the violation gets filed at the Hamilton County Courthouse.
- Talked about getting the new Township Trustee Kristie Dukes Davis to attend a meeting early next year.
- Mentioned Birchridge apartments did not have dumpsters and garbage piled up in parking lot. Joe had township address and cleanup.
- Talked about getting trash cans at all bus stops to prevent litter.
- Talked about getting Township to send out a letter to all residence and businesses similar to the "Sevenhills High Priority" letter sent out in 2018.
