We had 6 attendees \$19 donations collected

- Opened meeting talking about easements in area between sidewalk and road. Large rocks that were placed to prevent cars from driving up in grass had to be removed.
- Talked about doing a Dump Your Junk event in late April. Request a large dumpster and another small for tires.
- Went over code violations. Large refrigerated trailer behind House Joint Bar on Roosevelt. Garbage cans and bags of trash stored in front yards. Cars parked on lawns. Blighted and unoccupied/abandoned houses with out of town owners not responding. Township once mentioned they would tear them down and offer to sell empty lot to adjacent home owners. Andy Seiter and Mike Gould are good ones to contact about issues and solutions.
- Lots of large trash items such as refrigerators and appliances buried down in creek between Frost Park and Roosevelt. Very hard to get to. No solution to clean up at this time.
- Trying to get the Township to send out a newsletter to remind neighbors to maintain lawns and homes.
- A suggestion was made to get a group together and go to town hall meeting.
- The drive going to church lot still has pot holes but is in cue for Township to fix.
- Someone mentioned the Quail Woods Apartments has new owner.
- Looking for solution for Metro Bus route improvements such as shelter and repaving roads on route now that Hamilton county tax is approved.
- Speeding still a problem. No solution at this time.
