- Opened meeting letting everyone know Carolyn Mathews, one of the founders of SHAG passed away Saturday Jun 25th
- Brought up resident issues, High grass, garbage piled up, cars on lawns, abandoned houses and vehicles.
- Andina and Donald Gentry introduced Themselves. First time at meeting.
- Someone asked if it's OK to have chickens. No one knew.
- Talked about speed humps similar to those in Colerain Township on Niagara near Loralinda. Sevenhills Dr and Roosevelt has lot's of speeding.
- Talked about a good time to set up a round table meeting with the Township Staff and/or Trustees. A Tuesday mid to late afternoon suggested. Anyone in the Township is welcome to attend. The Township is putting together a letter to send out to all residents and businesses of Sevenhills after the meeting to address issues.
- Someone suggested a larger neighborhood welcome sign just east of the bus stop on Roosevelt.
- Talked about how some of the Township neighborhoods seem to get much better treatment than Sevenhills.
- Someone Mentioned an abandoned house on Sprucehill has been sitting vacant for a few years now and structurally unstable.
- Explained who is responsible for what on the township staff.
- Someone mentioned that Roosevelt West of Hamilton Ave. has been re-paved up to the Colerain/Springfield Township border on the Colerain side and stopped.
- Talked about how Shottelkotte park was leased out to Star Soccer taking away another park. Explained it was OK to access when no Soccer but by foot only because parking lots are closed off to residents, only open for Star Soccer.
- Mentioned about a shootout at Roosevelt and Sprucehill. No one injured/killed.
