



February 24th, 2025 Meeting Minutes

- A NeatStreets cleanup event for picking up trash along the streets of Sevenhills is set up by the township for Saturday April 26th, 9AM to 12 PM. Will have an additional 30' dumpster for a dump your junk event. We need volunteer support from the neighborhood to qualify for future dump your junk events. The township will distribute door hang tags to help promote the event. [Event details from township are HERE](#).

- Improvements are temporarily on hold for improving Sevenhills Park (formerly Frost Park) for soccer due to publics work busy fixing road infrastructure (Potholes). Will resume in a few months. Also in process of getting approval for a volley ball court.
- Grant is back on for paving Sprucehill and other nearby roads using METRO SORTA grant. Hoping grant also includes a pull off for the bus on Roosevelt. Should know if approved by July.
- Flower Pots will be set back up in MAY after frost season ends.
- The owner of Barber shop on Hamilton Ave is interested in promoting a music event with food truck at Sevenhills park. Exploring logistics at this time.
- Was asked about "The House Joint" bar at Hamilton & Roosevelt. Front part appears to be used.
- Barb wire fence on Sevenhills Dr. by Auto Shop violates Forest Park zoning ([see § 150.17 FENCES, WALLS, AND HEDGES part \(D\) Prohibited fences](#)), but nothing is being done about it. Suggested going to Forest Park Public meeting, 1st and 3rd Monday of month at 7PM. If not corrected by early April, we plan to attend the meeting April 21st. Meeting located at [Forest Park Municipal Building](#) across from Kroger on Kemper Rd.
- A suggestion was made for a neighborhood outdoor flea market, but code requires all public events must be done indoors. It's OK to have Yard sales selling personal items at resident location.
- A burnt out streetlight on Roosevelt near Pleasanthill was reported to Duke for repair.
- Shottelkotte park may be rezoned for light industrial after lease with Star Soccer is up.
- A reminder [Springfield Township ArtsConnect](#) has many events and classes for residents.
- A suggestion for future development was made for a pickleball court.
- Was asked about purchasing empty adjacent property lots and if they can be repurposed for other uses than a new house. No one knew process.
- There's a problem with mosquitos near watershed areas on Aspenhill. Not sure who's responsible for treatment.
