



April 28th, 2025 Meeting Minutes

- Reviewed NeatStreet event, April 26th. Overall not to trashy. A few heavy volume trash areas were cleaned; Sevenhills Dr. between Sunoco and Birchridge, Ally behind DMV and church, SW end of Aspenhill Dr., Mistyhill and Maplehill dead ends by golf course. and all of Roosevelt. A truck did curbside large volume trash pickup in several locations. Lots of trees and brush on north dead end of Sprucehill was too much to clean. Will notify code enforcement.
- Soccer goals are up with netting on order. Should be completed sometime in May. A sand volley ball court and horse shoe pit will be add in the next few months.
- Roads in the cue for repave include Sprucehill, Birchridge, Sevenhills, and Roosevelt. An off ramp for Meto bus will also be added on Roosevelt at the 17 end of line. A bus shelter may be added at a later time.
- Discussed the many recent group homes popping up in the neighborhood resulting in high volume of police calls. Will investigate how to be notified when they are added and if there is a way to block more future.
- Some houses have mold on them and need washed down and will be addressed.
- Talked about having a concert in the park event at Sevenhills park with local bands and food trucks. Will contact township Arts Connect to go over logistics involved to see if this can be done.
- Talked about doing a neighborhood flea market when [World's Longest Yard Sale](#) takes place August 7-10, 2025. It goes 610 miles up US127 (Hamilton Ave.) from Alabama to Michigan. Springfield Township Code limits yard sales to single resident on own property only. Forest Park zoning may allow it (old Kmart lot behind Taco Bell now owned by Forest Park). Will investigate.
