



## June 23rd, 2025 Meeting Minutes

### \$50 Donations

- We are in the process of setting up a flea market in collaboration with the church for July 26<sup>th</sup> Fall Fea market. No date set yet, but not in July. \$40 for 4 spots already collected.
- Lisa Young is planning to run for Township Trustee on the November ballot and looking for support. We helped with ballot signatures needed to get approved.
- Sheriff is looking to foreclose neglected/abandoned property on Sprucehill Dr. and auctioned off. It can be very expensive to tear down and fill in basement (around \$40K) and person buying at auction needs to pay for it, making restoring a better option.
- Sevenhills Park sign with landscaping is in progress, work to begin soon.
- Sand Volleyball court is approved and work will begin early July. 4 stakes will be placed in the location behind the shelter (net will face East/West) by Friday June 27<sup>th</sup> for anyone who to check out and suggest final tweaks before work begins in July.
- A grant from SORTA was reapplied by township for a Bus Pull off at the 17 EOL on Roosevelt along with repaving of Sprucehill and other adjacent roads. If approved work should start in fall.
- The temporary construction site at the old Kmart lot on Waycross in Forest Park is in the process of moving out.
- The soccer goals at the park are now cemented down to prevent future vandalism.
- Wooded area at SW dead end of Aspen Hill has excessive trash from possible illegal dumping. Excessive trash on Bluehill cleaned up by Township.
- Reminded everyone that Township chipper service is still available, making it easy to get rid of excessive brush.
- We talked about making improvements to the Soccer field at the park to make it eligible for league games. Went over logistics for starting an faa league such as collecting fees for services such a referee, setting up a 501(c)3 nonprofit, liability wavers. Shottelkotte lease with Star Soccer will be done this year with future plans for park not determined at this time.
- Speeding still a problem and township will not install speed humps.
- Street light on Pleasanthill fixed. Duke said any pole with electric can have a streetlight installed, and paid for by township or homeowner at \$8 per month.
- Tall grass violations apply to front yards only, not back yards.
- Talked about a movie night at the park at the soccer field. Park closed Dusk to Dawn so special permit may be needed. Also need to get power to location. Saturday July 12<sup>th</sup> suggested.
