



April 26th, Meeting Minutes

- SHAG meeting will resume at church Starting May and moved to Mondays.
- The Sevenhills NeatStreet event was a success thanks to the help of Overflow Ministries Covenant Church. Still a large volume of hard to reach trash in creek South of basketball court in park. Heavy over growth along fence line behind church and day care made trash pickup difficult. Township Public works plans to take care of this in future.
- Gambling by Sunoco still a problem. Township Public works plans to remove bushes in the area that makes it easy to hide illegal activity.
- Suggest to add a Youth size soccer field to Sevenhills park. For 9 to 12 year olds the field is 25 x 70 Yards and goal 6.5 x 18.5 ft. Suggested adding a parking lot if field used for team events for visitor parking.
- Basketball court will be completely resurfaced with new markings.
- Went over Mt Healthy school 1% earned income tax levy on May primary ballot. It's not a property tax. It's a tax on earned income. Does not tax retirement income such as IRA, 401K, or other investment income. The tax is for current operating and will not restore bus service. If levy fails, more cuts will be needed to extra-curricular such as sports and music programs.
- Brought up how dangerous it is for kids walking to school in areas with no sidewalks.
- Discussed location for Metro bus pull off on Rosevelt. Project planned for Summer 27.
- Talked about doing a flea market at church location to raise SHAG funds. Would need to meet with church to work out logistics.
